IFC Formal Recruitment Alcohol Penalties Resolution

Whereas, all recruitment activities within the Greek system are to be done without the presence or consumption of alcohol.

Whereas, all chapters within the IFC exist under the University Recognition Policy, and must abide by any changes made to said policies.

Whereas, the IFC wishes to define and establish penalties for the any alcohol-related incidents.

Be it Therefore Resolved, that the Interfraternity Council sets forth the following penalties for incidents related to alcohol during the formal recruitment period:

(Beer, Wine, Malt Liquor, etc.): Incidents with alcohol not under the category of hard alcohol (beer, wine, etc.) shall incur a recommended sanction of a lost day of formal recruitment activities, a recommended 4 weeks social probation and a \$500 fine. Incidents that occur on the final night of rush will result in a recommendation for an additional 4 weeks of social probation.

Hard Alcohol: Incidents with hard alcohol will result in a recommendation to revoke the chapter's privileges to participate in the remainder of formal recruitment, a recommended 8 weeks of social probation, and a \$1000 fine(see: Rush Resolution 2006). On a case by case basis, this may incur a loss of bidding privileges for that semester. Incidents that occur on the final night of rush will result in recommendation of an additional social probation up to the length of the subsequent semester.

Multiple Incidents: A chapter found to have violated any alcohol policy more than once during formal recruitment may lose its privileges to participate in the remainder of formal recruitment.
